

Come be part of WMNF's 27th Tropical Heatwave Street Bazaar !!! 88.5fm Community Radio

Each year, 9th Avenue is transformed into the Tropical Heatwave Street Bazaar. WMNF seeks Arts and Crafts vendors to sell their wares, and Community Groups who would like to make festival-goers aware of their organizations.

Community groups: provide information about their services, and don't sell anything. No water, no cookies, no brownies, no books. No exceptions.

The fee for Community Groups is \$30. This is for one space, and does not include admission to Tropical Heatwave. Up to two (2) tickets for admission to Tropical Heatwave can be purchased in advance for \$20 each.

Arts and Crafts vendors: sell things like jewelry, clothes, and books. No water, no cookies, no brownies. No exceptions.

The fee for arts and crafts vendors is \$60. This is for one space, and does not include admission to Tropical Heatwave. Up to two (2) tickets for admission to Tropical Heatwave can be purchased in advance for \$20 each.

Booth Information: Space size is approximately 10 feet by 10 feet, uncovered, with no electricity. You must provide your own set-up, table(s), chair(s), and garbage bags (for trash). There are streetlights, but the area is not completely lit. Bring battery-powered lanterns if you need more lighting.

Set-Up: is at 3:00 p.m., and must be completed by 5:30 p.m. Tear-down time is up to you. Tropical Heatwave will end around 2:00 a.m. You will not be able to drive your vehicle onto 9th Avenue for tear-down, so plan accordingly. An Ybor City parking garage is located at the west end of 9th Avenue. It's close and inexpensive.

Space size: approximately 10 feet by 10 feet, uncovered, no electricity. You must provide your own set-up, table, chairs and trash bags. There are streetlights, but the area is not completely lit. Bring battery-powered lanterns if you need more lighting.

Set-Up: 9th Avenue will be closed by 3:00 pm. Try to arrive by 4:00 pm. Set-up must be completed by 5:30 pm. A volunteer will direct you to your assigned spot. Please be courteous and unload your vehicle quickly.

Tear-down: Tear down time is up to you. The music ends around 2:00 am. You can staff your booth for as long as you like. Be careful when loading and leaving, and thanks for cleaning up around your spot. You will not be able to drive your vehicle onto 9th Avenue for tear-down, so plan accordingly.

Parking: A city parking garage is located at the end of 9th Avenue. It's close and inexpensive.
